TEAMtalk Satellite is a specialist maritime communications company, which provides a specialised newspaper delivery service to the yachting industry.

The benefits of this service are many: newspapers come in a unique ready-to-print A4/letter layout; This is ideal for printing, requiring no special equipment. Guests can read them at breakfast, lunch or dinner and your crew can keep in touch with news from home. They are completely up to date - a real bonus for remote and exotic locations where news is normally late arriving.

All newspapers contain up-to-date news covering politics, lifestyle, showbiz, sport and finance.

TEAMtalk SatNews packages comprise:

- SatNews editions – multi-language news produced by our team of multilingual news editors using material sourced from a number of international and national press agencies including Associated Press, Agence France Presse, etc.
- National newspaper digests ('Mastheads') – abridged editions of news syndicated from some of the world's favourite daily newspapers.

The SatNews service carries a very reasonable monthly usage charge.

- 1 daily newspaper delivery - €150 per month
- 2 daily newspaper deliveries - €230 per month (depending on titles)

Receiving newsfiles

The service can be received by Inmarsat A, B, M, GSM, Iridium and Mini-M users (or any vessel that has an Internet e-mail facility not linked to a Sat C unit).

The newsfiles can be downloaded from TEAMtalk Satellite's Super-Hub using special software (if you are a subscriber to the TEAMtalk communications hub) or delivered via e-mail directly to an Internet mailbox as a file attachment (not connected to an Inmarsat C terminal). All the required software for printing the news files is provided by free-of-charge (NB: 1.3 megabytes in size and can either be sent or downloaded).

File size

- TEAMtalk SatNews papers include 1-page, 2-page, 4-page and 9-page editions.
- All SatNews 4-page editions contain around 4,500 words.
- 2-page ZIP and TXT newsfiles are approx 7K.
- 4-page ZIP and TXT newsfiles are approx 15K.
- 9-page ZIP and TXT newsfiles are approx 30K.

Obviously, plain text formats are less, but as you can see, all the files are very small in terms of byte size regardless of format delivered.
